Our last hard copy newsletter was sent out in January, 2016. So what has happened since January?

- Worship Conference We held our first Detroit Worship Conference in April. It was very well received.
- Summer Courses We had our summer term of courses, including our new Instrumental Ensemble which concluded with a concert at Eastside Community Church in Eastpointe.
- Partnership with Motor Cities Metro Baptist Association We have built a partnership with MCMBA. They are providing a scholarship of 2/3 tuition for members from any of their churches who attend WAC.
- Midtown location We found a location in Midtown to host our classes. It is called "The Block" and it is located at 2727 2nd Avenue in Midtown Detroit.
- Student growth Growth at WAC has been slow but we are starting to see the results of our work. In 2014-15 we averaged 1 student per term (because we had some terms with no students). In 2015-16 we averaged 5 students per term and we currently have 10 students enrolled for our 2016-17 Fall term!


The wind ensemble allowed me to take my high school level experience and polish it to

WAC offers people the opportunity to be trained in ministry without having to relocate or leave their current ministry.

FUNDRAISING STATUS

Thank you to those who have supported us. Your generous donations are impacting ministries and touching lives. An additional \$7,000-10,000, however, is needed to finish out the current year. To continue to be effective and grow as a college we need to raise between \$100,000-\$150,000 next year.

What we will do with \$100,000

- Continue working full time at the Conservatory
- · Increase our advertising reach and develop more professional marketing materials
- · Get licensed by the State of Michigan for on-site courses
- Hire professional help for tasks like website management and marketing so more focus can be placed on networking and academics.

Over the last few years more than 60 people have donated to WAC, but through the advise of fundraising consultants it has become clear that we are missing a very important component—monthly partners. To date, most of our donations have been one time gifts.

It is very difficult to build a budget and develop an organization on one time gifts. What we need now is for our one time donors to become monthly partners. To reach our goal of \$100,000-\$150,000 we will need a few to give \$12,000-15,000. But just as important are those who can give \$25-50 per month. A typical organization seeking to raise \$100,000 will need more than 20 people giving at the \$25-\$500 level each month. You may not be able to give the larger amounts, but please consider partnering with us at a level that is reasonable for you.

If you are not comfortable with any of the pre-selected giving levels you can use the "one time donation" box. Click the donate button and then enter the amount you wish to donate. Don't forget that you can make this a repeat donation by clicking the box.

- Kroger Community Rewards <u>Enroll/Re-enroll</u> with your Kroger Plus Card. Sign up at www.KrogerCommunityRewards.com and choose us as your charity. Our Organization Number is 30960. That's it! Every time you make a purchase using your Kroger Plus Card a percentage will be donated to us. <u>Kroger requires re-enrollment each April to continue in</u> <u>the program, so if you have not re-enrolled for this year we encourage you to take a</u> <u>moment to do so.</u>
